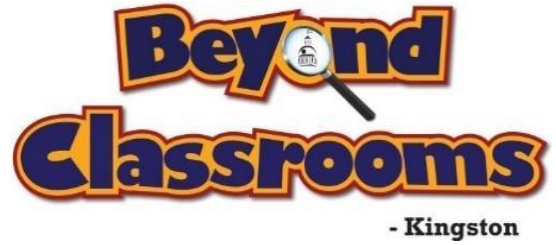

1. Identify Basic Shapes

2. Observe the Light Source

Where is the light coming from? Use the space below to draw an arrow showing the direction of the light.

4. Add Shading
