Beyond Classrooms immerses elementary students and teachers in Kingston's community sites for slowed-down inquiry-based learning. Students learn to look closely and think critically about collections while capturing their sketches and learning in journals.

The Spring Program consists of four activities connected to a host museum this May:

- An in-class journal workshop with BCK at your school. Students will learn to sketch & reflect on mystery objects.
- Two online virtual "Ask an Expert" visits where students ask questions. Community experts provide in-depth topic knowledge related to the museum
- An in-person visit to the museum (day or half-day) where students will explore, journal, learn, and have fun!

We place students' questions and curiosities at the heart of our inquiry-based program. Students develop skills in literacy, sketching, asking questions, and critical thinking.
